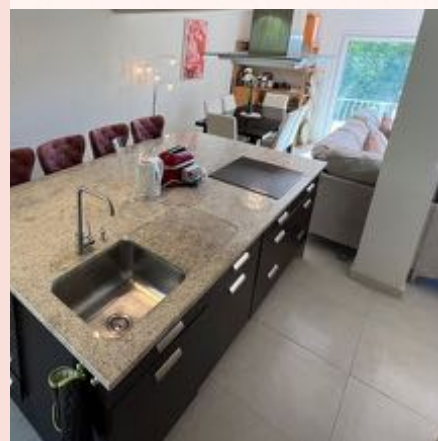

## NICE CÔTE D'AZUR AIRPORT



On arrival at the airport, you can either take a taxi to Eze-Sur-Mer where La Pitchounette is situated (taxi's are located outside the airport) or you can take a simple combination of the tram and the train. It's a good idea to download the apps below before you arrive, as they will help you get around.

### Lignes d'Azur Mobile

The official mobile application of the Métropole Nice Côte d'Azur. It is designed to facilitate your travel on all the urban lines of the Lignes d'Azur network. 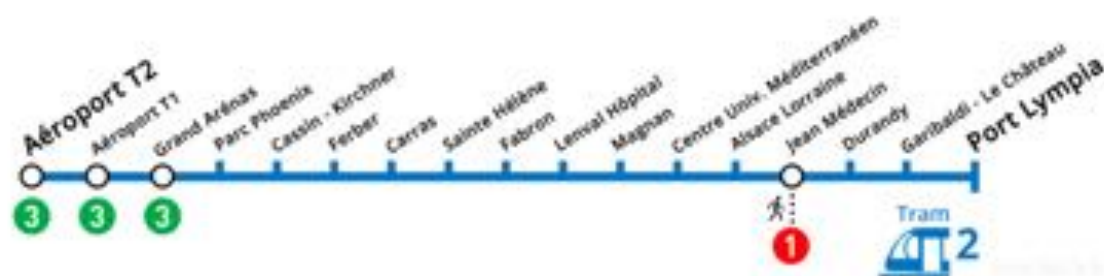

# VILLA INFORMATION

Once inside the gates, head to the side of the Villa where you will find the door to enter. Here you will find a lockbox, the code for this is  Once inside, you will find all the other keys (including car key) hung up in the entrance.



There is a 1 bedroom studio on the ground floor, the main living space is on the first floor and the final 2 bedrooms and bathrooms on the second floor.

In the garden there is a detached studio - this should only be used if the 3 bedrooms in the villa are all used. There is also a laundry room with a washing machine and dryer, and storage shed in the garden, all keys are on the hooks if required.

- There is a table tennis table, bats are in the dresser in the main villa
- There is various outdoor furniture, feel free to move around as required
- If you have arranged to use the Volvo you must be over 30 to be insured
- The key to the laundry room is fussy in the lock, you need to hold the barrel back slightly as you turn or remove the key
- The villa is fully equipped with aircon throughout, and the kitchen is equipped with appliances (oven, fridge freezer, kettle, toaster etc.)
- To switch on the hot water, flick the labelled switch on the fuse box, located in cupboard in entrance of main villa/hatch to the right of the door in separate studio)
- Bath towels are provided, please bring your own beach towels. (Most beach clubs will supply these with bed hire.)
- If you have a late flight home you may store baggage in downstairs hallway/studio on your day of departure, this must be collected before 4pm.



# Local Amenities

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## SUPERMARKET

Super U, 1 Rue du 8 Mai 1945, 06310 Beaulieu-Sur-Mer, France

The closest supermarket is located in Beaulieu-Sur-Mer, the next town from Eze. You can get the train opposite the Villa and go one stop to Beaulieu-Sur-Mer, where the supermarket is located just to the right of the station. It also has an underground carpark if you go in the car. It's a really good, well stocked supermarket.



## BEACH

Eze has a pebble beach which is a short walk from the Villa. This can be accessed via the footbridge opposite the gate. As it's pebbles, I suggest taking an old sun lounge cushion to sit on.

For a more cosmopolitan atmosphere, hop on the 100 bus to Monaco or Nice. Be aware trains/buses stop quite early in France so plan your return before 9pm. Ubers are available in France but only official Monaco taxis are available in Monaco, which will cost you €50 to Eze or €2 on the bus / €4 on the train!

# SUGGESTED DAYS OUT

## Eze Village

Eze Village is a beautiful medieval village that towers over Eze-Sur-Mer, 400m above sea level. You are able to walk from Eze-Sur-Mer along the Nietzsche which you can join just outside the villa (left as you come out of the gate) - this is a rather steep but beautiful walk. If you prefer, you can get the 83 bus from outside the Villa which will take you there!

# Suggested Days Out

## MONACO

Visit Monaco easily by train or the 600 bus; you can wander the chic streets of Monte Carlo, visit the iconic Casino Square, have a drink in Le Café de Paris and see the superyachts in the main Port Hercules! I like the prince's car collection museum - fab to see for any petrol head. You can also walk the F1 track which is being built March-April and in use in May! ### Nice

As the largest city in the area, head to Nice and enjoy all that this vibrant cosmopolitan city has to offer.
